

## Using Market Implied Ratings (MIR<sup>®</sup>) on the New Moodys.com Frequently Asked Questions

The Moodys.com Autumn 2009 release introduces a more deeply integrated MIR<sup>®</sup> with powerful new charting, peer analysis, integrated portfolios, and data reporting. Using MIR to analyze and monitor your credits has never been easier.

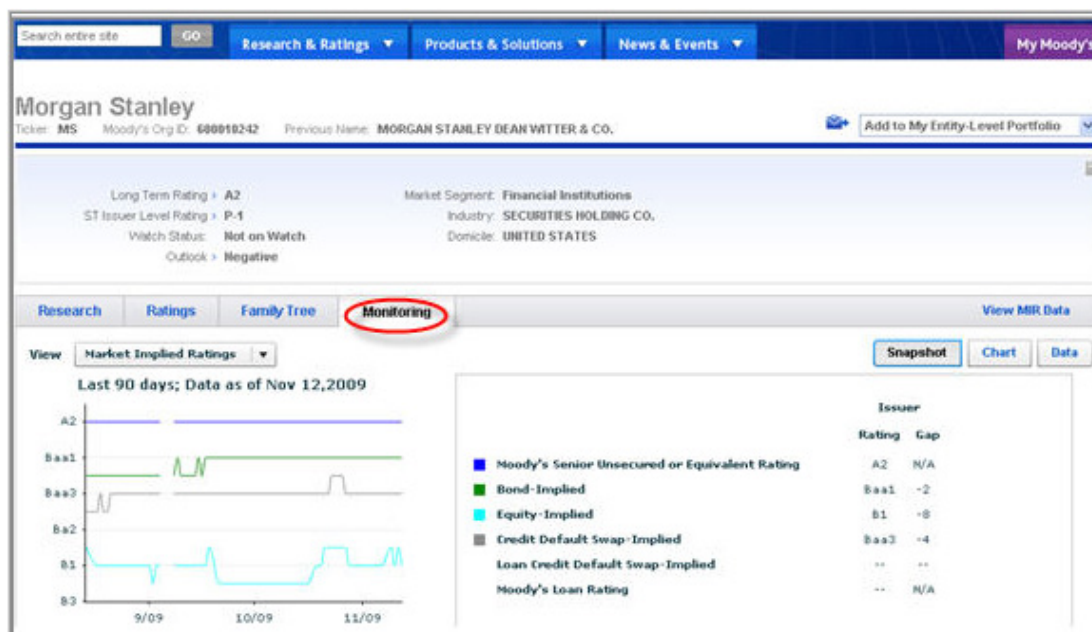
### 1. How do I access MIR on the New Moodys.com?

You can continue to access MIR as you currently do, or you can start using the enhanced features:

- i Issuer At-A-Glance pages: Access MIR content for single issuers directly from the new "Monitoring" tab of each issuer's At-A-Glance page
- ii Portfolios: View MIR data for single issuers or portfolio level statistics by simply choosing the "Market Implied Ratings" view for any of your portfolios.

### 2. How do I search for a company?

Search directly in the new Moodys.com site search using issuer name, ticker, CUSIP or other identifiers. Once you arrive at the issuer page, click on the Monitoring tab to access MIR content.



### 3. How do I view a table of historical MIR data?

Within the new Monitoring tab, click on the "Data" button to view the full historical MIR data for the obligor.

### 4. How do I chart MIR data?

Within the new Monitoring tab, click on the "Chart" button to use the new advanced chart features. Here you can customize the chart content: change time period, modify frequency and compare to peers.

### 5. How do I conduct peer analysis?

Compare an issuer to its peers in the new advanced charting feature. Simply search for and add a peer using the "Compare" search box in the bottom right of the chart. You can compare up to two issuers at a time across six measures.

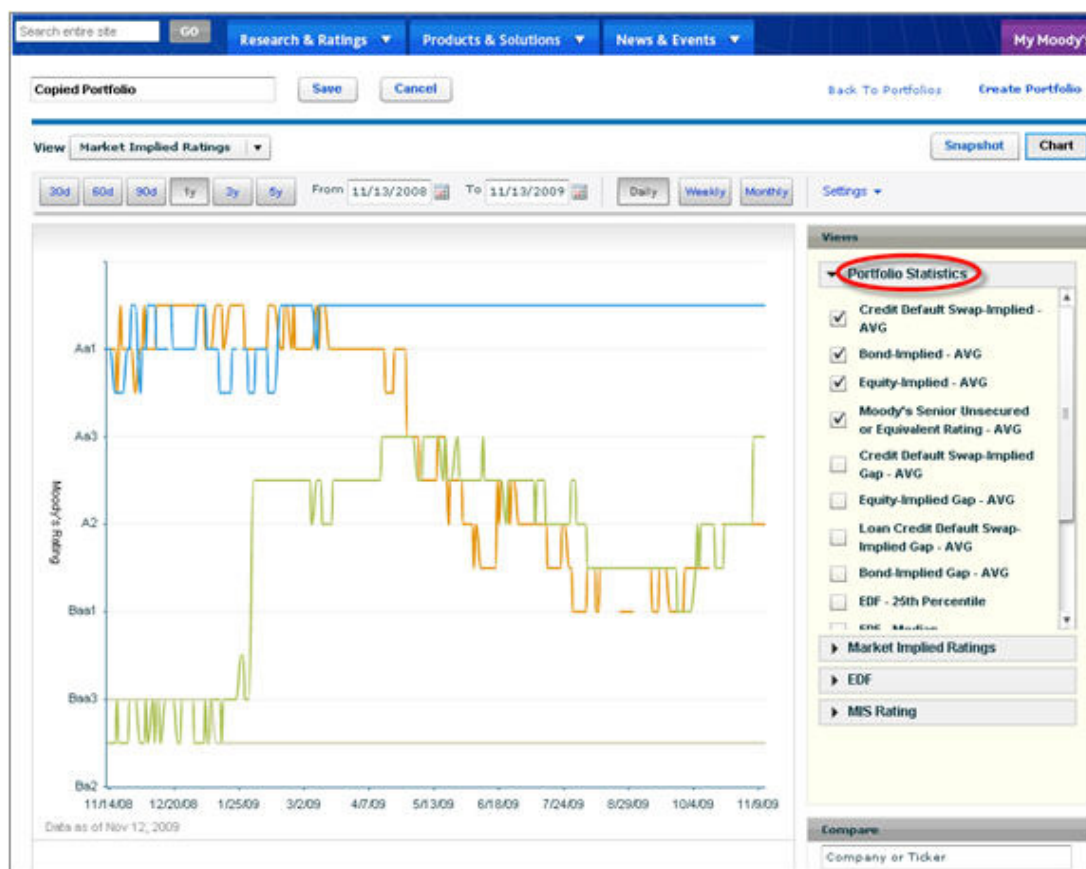
### 6. How do I create portfolios?

You can now access MIR data from any of your Moodys.com portfolios. To update or create new portfolios you can:

- i Search: You can search for individual issuers using the site search and then add to/create a portfolio using the drop-down option from the top right corner of the issuer's At-A-Glance page
- ii My Moody's: Upload your entire portfolio in a single instance by creating a portfolio using "My Moody's" from the top right corner of the homepage. You can import a variety of identifiers from CUSIPs to Moody's Org IDs to add to or create your portfolio.

### 7. How do I view MIR portfolio statistics?

From within your portfolio, select the Market Implied Ratings view. From here you will be able to view a snapshot of the portfolio's MIR statistics or go to the advanced charting feature.





## 8. How do I view MIR Transition Matrices and Median Credit Spreads?

From the Products & Solutions tab in the main site navigation, select “Access Products”, then Market Implied Ratings.

## 9. How do I export and print?

Whether you are using the advanced charting feature or simply viewing the issuer data, you can export or print the information from the Monitoring tab at any time by clicking on the “View MIR Data” link on the top right corner and then selecting the Download to Excel or Printer Friendly options.
